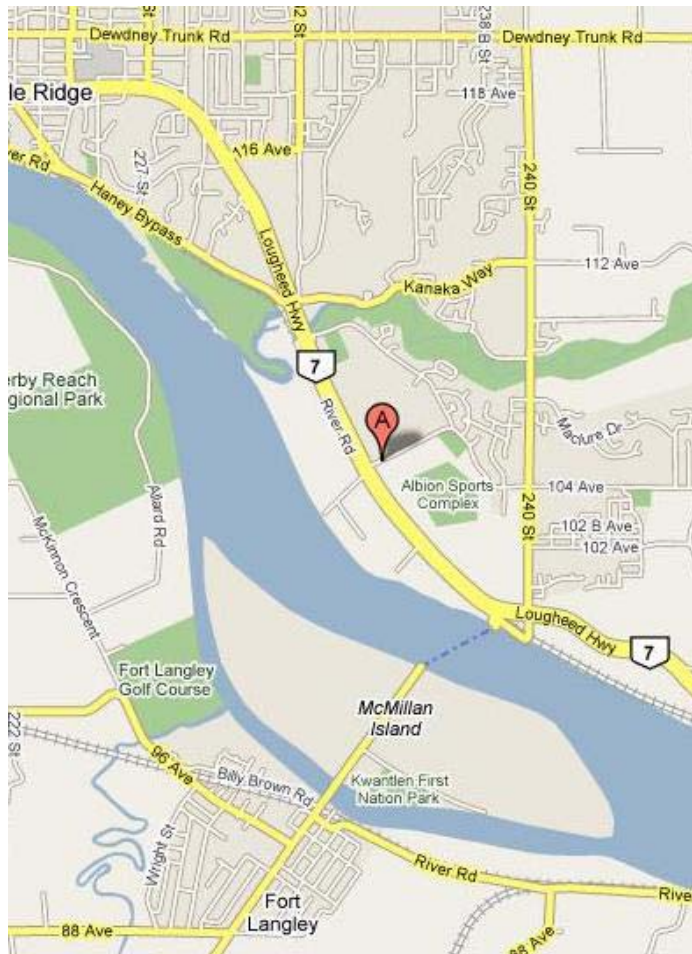

Trophies

Qualifying scores must be earned in order to be eligible for prizes and trophies.

Ribbons will be awarded for all qualifying scores. Rosettes will be awarded for:

High in Trial
High in Class
2nd to 4th place qualifiers

A prize will be offered for High In Trial

A toy will be offered for all Labrador Retrievers that earn a Qualifying Score.

Instructions to Exhibitors and Rules Governing this Rally Trial

The event will be held outdoors and cover will not be provided in case of inclement weather.

It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer, or competitor at a Rally Obedience Trial held under these regulations, is not be subject to indignities of any kind. The Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred..

No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act.

No person shall enter or exhibit a dog under a judge where that judge has owned, conditioned, sold, handled, held under lease or boarded within 6 months prior to the date of the show at which he officiates as a judge. This rule shall apply regardless of whether the judge benefited in any way from any of the aforementioned activities. It is the responsibility of the owner to see that this rule is not violated.

Entry fees will be refunded when a bitch entered in obedience comes into season, after entry of the bitch has been submitted, if a Veterinarian's certificate (certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the trial) is presented to the trial secretary, at least one hour prior to the start of these trials.

If, because of civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the club, it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

Precincts of these trials will be the Maple Ridge Fairgrounds, Maple Ridge

Attention Foreign Exhibitors

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian Dollars only. Personal cheques will be accepted if they are in Canadian funds and drawn on a Canadian bank. **U.S. CHEQUES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**

Border Crossing

A valid rabies certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada. Government regulations require a certificate and it must be dated at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada. Canadian Food Inspection Agency regulations can be viewed at:

Foreign Born/Foreign Owned Dog

For the purpose of entering CKC events to obtain CKC titles, individual registration is not required for foreign born, foreign owned dogs. Foreign exhibitors may apply for an **Event Registration Number (ERN)**. This number MUST be applied for within 30 days of entering first CKC event to avoid cancellation. Dogs that have an AKC ILP certificate may exhibit with a **Performance Event Number (PEN)**. .
